## Ohio Wesleyan Outcomes

A Follow-up Study of the Class of 2002

September, 2003

This summer Career Services conducted its annual survey to study the career journeys of Ohio Wesleyan graduates. Questionnaires were sent out to Ohio Wesleyan University graduates approximately one year after their graduation. Initially, graduates were e-mailed a link to the survey or, if an e-mail address was not available, mailed a paper copy of the survey with a postage-paid return envelope and instructions about the option of filling out the survey on-line. For those who did not respond to this original communication, individuals who were originally e-mailed were sent a follow-up e-mail reminder and then a paper copy of the survey was sent to them. If graduates did not respond to the paper mailing of the survey, they were sent a postcard reminder. These communications yielded a return rate of 37.96% of the Class of 2002.

We hope this report will serve as a reference guide for all faculty, staff, students, parents, and alumni interested in career-related statistics for recent Ohio Wesleyan graduates.

Even though we continue to face economic challenges as a country, Ohio Wesleyan's Class of 2002 graduates are successfully employed in a variety of areas. *The percentage of graduates employed upon graduation or during the first two months following graduation increased by approximately 10% from the Class of 2001. Securing full-time employment in their field of choice, however, was quite similar to last year—79% for the 2002 grads compared to 76% for the 2001 graduates. It should be noted that the economic challenges in this country are most likely continuing to affect this figure, as in 2000, 88% of graduates employed full-time reported finding work in their field of choice.*

*Thirty-two percent of graduates chose to pursue graduate studies, compared with 34% of 2001 graduates. The current status of the Class of 2002 is as follows:*

67% are currently employed 21% are enrolled in graduate school 11% are enrolled in graduate school and employed 1% are involved in other endeavors or were not employed at the time of the survey






## CURRENT STATUS: CLASS OF 2002



## COMPARATIVE DATA: CLASS OF 2001




## COMPARATIVE DATA: CLASS OF 2000




# STUDY OF THE CLASS OF 2002 GRADUATES EMPLOYED FULL-TIME


Starting Salaries - Full-Time Employment




