

Gregory L. Moore '76 Alumni Award

The Ohio Wesleyan University Alumni Association Board of Directors proudly presents the Alumni Award to **Gregory L. Moore '76**. We honor his extraordinary devotion of time, talent, and treasure to Ohio Wesleyan. While Greg's professional career is historic, including leading *The Denver Post* to four consecutive Pulitzer Prizes and serving as co-chair of the Pulitzer Prize Board, today we celebrate his tireless commitment to the life of this university.

Greg serves Ohio Wesleyan with both depth and diversity. As a former member of the OWU Board of Trustees, he also serves on the *OWU Magazine* Alumni Editorial Advisory Board, volunteers within admission and university advancement, and mentors students. In 2016, Greg gave the commencement address.

Greg often tells the story of how Ohio Wesleyan "chose him" during a frantic application process in 1972. In the 50 years since he graduated, Greg has "chosen OWU" and prioritizes ensuring today's Bishops have access to the same opportunities that meant so much to him. He has been a strong supporter of multicultural initiatives, has helped open doors for students entering the workforce, and continues to invest in the university's future. Through his generous financial contributions, Greg has supported OWU's Butler A. Jones House of Black Culture, the Willa B. Player Black Resource Center in Stuyvesant Hall, a mission trip to Ghana, and many other OWU initiatives. Greg is a member of the President's Circle.

Already a recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Citation and OWU's Office of Multicultural Student Affairs Alumni of the Year Award, Greg continues to define what it means to be a "good citizen of the world."
