

John “Jack” Luikart ’71 Alumni Award

The Ohio Wesleyan Alumni Association Board of Directors is honored to recognize **Jack Luikart ’71** with the Alumni Award for his longtime dedication to Ohio Wesleyan and his efforts to advance the mission of the university.

Jack graduated with a degree in economics and is a member of Delta Tau Delta. His career includes serving as a partner at Prescott, Ball & Turban, as president and CEO of Sutro, and as chairman of Wedbush Securities.

Since graduating from OWU, he has served in several alumni and admission volunteer roles, most notably as an at-large member of the OWU Board of Trustees. On the board, Jack’s service included the executive committee, the organization committee, the audit subcommittee, the investment subcommittee, and the chair of the finance and operations committee.

Jack’s dedication to OWU extends far beyond his service to the Board. Jack and his wife, **Lorry Haycock Luikart ’73**, have been lifelong OWU event attendees both on campus and throughout the country, including the San Francisco alumni events they have hosted in their home.

Jack has impacted campus life through his and Lorry’s contributions to the construction of the Butler A. Jones House of Black Culture, and they have been loyal supporters of the Fine Arts at Ohio Wesleyan, giving generously to the Richard M. Ross Art Museum and establishing the Haycock Luikart Director’s Endowment. They have made Ohio Wesleyan a more artful space by establishing The Ebb and Teena Haycock Public Art Endowment to place public art across OWU’s campus. Jack and Lorry also established The Luikart Family Endowment and The Marge & Ford Luikart Scholarship Fund. Jack and Lorry are members of the President’s Circle and Founders’ Circle.
