Sarah built her foundation at Ohio Wesleyan, earning degrees in politics & government, Spanish, and Latin American studies. After studying at the Universidad de Salamanca, she graduated with honors from Capital University Law School and emerged as a dedicated champion for Ohio's working class.

At Barkan Meizlish and Wentz, McInerney, Peifer & Petroff, LLC, Sarah distinguished herself as a fierce advocate for public- and private-sector unions. She negotiated collective bargaining agreements and litigated wage- and-hour claims for pilots, teachers, and firefighters, spanning the labor movement. She uses her bilingual proficiency to bridge gaps in legal access for Spanish-speaking clients.

In 2021, Sarah was named a Super Lawyers Rising Star, a prestigious distinction reserved for 2.5 % of eligible attorneys. This honor followed a decorated law school career, during which she received the National Association of Women Lawyers Outstanding Law Student Award and was inducted into the Order of the Barristers.

Beyond the courtroom, Sarah translates legal expertise into systemic change. She testifies before the Ohio Senate and publishes influential work on living wages and workers' compensation. Currently, Sarah serves as chief of staff and general counsel to the Minority Caucus of the Ohio House of Representatives, guiding strategic policy to keep underrepresented voices at the forefront of the state's agenda. She also leads as vice president of the Columbus Board of Education, championing educational equity.

Sarah mentors the next generation, believing that resilient women leaders drive transformative results through empathy and collaboration. At OWU, Sarah has volunteered for career, admission, and annual giving initiatives. She is a member of the Tower Society.
