- **CSCC General Education Requirements**: Students should choose the General Education courses for the AA degree in consultation with their academic and faculty advisors.
- **OWU General Education Requirements:** Students who complete an Associate of Science or an Associate of Arts degree from CSCC will have the OWU general education requirements waived except for the <u>OWU Connection requirement</u>. Students who do not complete the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degrees at CSCC prior to transfer to Ohio Wesleyan will need to complete whatever course work remains for OWU's general education requirement at Ohio Wesleyan. This may extend a student's time to degree to account for the additional course work.

- **CSCC Degree Plan:** This Sample Graduation Plan was created with the assumption that students would complete the AA Early Childhood Education Major before transferring into the stated bachelor's degree. Completing the general Associate of Arts degree is also an option and this document can still be used for degree planning. If you have questions, contact a Columbus State Arts and Sciences Academic Advisor and an advisor at Ohio Wesleyan University.
- This program can be completed only in OWU's traditional day-time undergraduate program.
- To receive a degree from OWU, you must complete 34 "units" in total (units are equivalent to 3-4 semester credit hours) with 15 units at the 250 level and above, and 16 units at OWU during the junior and senior years. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0 and higher.
- \*\*Special Education Major Notes: Students must complete ENGL 1100, MATH 1125, PSY 1100, 2200, and 2551; EDUC 2210; and ECDE 1101 with a grade of "B" or higher and a GPA of 2.8 to apply to the Teacher Education Program. You will apply to the program in the fall of your junior year. **ECDE 1101:** Students should complete this course to meet a required major course for OWU. Students will need to petition this course with their Arts and Sciences Academic Advisor in Arts and Sciences Academic Advising (<a href="https://www.cscc.edu/services/advising/arts-sciences-advisors.shtml">https://www.cscc.edu/services/advising/arts-sciences-advisors.shtml</a>) for the course to apply to the AA Early Childhood Education major.

### Suggested Courses to Complete Requirements for the Associate of Arts Degree

### **Intermediate Composition**

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one course from ENGL 2367, 2467, 2567, 2667, or 2767.

### **Historical Study**

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one Historical Study course. Any course from the list on the AA plan of study can be chosen for this requirement.

# <u>Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual/Performing Arts</u>

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must take one course from Literature, Cultures & Ideas, Visual & Performing Arts. Any course from the list on the AA plan of study may be chosen for this requirement.

### **Natural Science**

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must take two science courses. At least one course must have a lab. GEOL 1101 or 1121 is required for the major and degree at OWU and will meet one of our two requirements and the lab requirement. The second science course may be a lab or a non-lab course and may be selected from the list on the AA plan of study.

# **OT-36 Exploration**

To earn the AA degree and the OT-36, Students must complete at least two additional courses from Social Science, Literature/Cultures and Ideas/Visual and Performing Arts, and Historical Study categories on the AA plan of study. For this pathway, students will complete POLS 1100 and PSY 2551 for this requirement and to meet requirements for the major at OWU.
