Comments on Switching to the Revised Business Minor

Switching to the revised Business Administration major or Business minor requires you to use the 2026-2027 OWU Catalog.

- For students on a catalog prior to the 2023-2024 OWU Catalog, the pre-2023 gen eds may cause a problem.
 - Single major: If you only have one major, switching to the 2023-2024 OWU Catalog will require switching your gen eds to the new core competencies.
 - More than one major: If you have two or more majors, the Registrar can keep your primary major set to your original catalog year and modify only the secondary (or tertiary) major. This keeps you on the prior gen eds.
 - Minor: Catalog years for minors can also be adjusted individually. This keeps you on the prior gen eds.
- For students who are already on the 2023-2024 (or later) catalog and following the new core competencies
 - There is no problem to switch students to a later catalog for one or all of their majors / minors.

BUS 140 Business Operations

- BUS 140 Business Operations is converting to an upper-level elective in the revised program and will be designated as BUS 340 Business Operations.
- Students that have completed BUS 140 during or prior to FA26 can use BUS 140 as one of the upper-level electives required in the revised Business Administration major.

No Course Substitutions Allowed

- For students switching to the revised Business Administration major or Business minor, there are no allowable course substitutions.
