Serving as the president of the Canton Monnett Club from 1987-1989 and then subsequently as the National Monnett Club President, Sue made a valiant effort to keep the National Association of Monnett Clubs alive in its final years. Recipient of the Monnett Club Award of Merit in 1991, her most significant contribution was to videotape discussions with alumnae of all ages for each local Monnett Club. After purchasing a video camera specifically for this project, Sue traveled to Columbus, Mansfield, Canton and Cincinnati to perform this labor of love.
