With this presentation of Ohio Wesleyan University's Alumni Award, the Ohio Wesleyan Alumni Association Board of Directors is proud to recognize **Denise B. Nock** for his commitment to the postgraduate careers of students through his work with the OWU Office of Career Services and development of the externship program.

Denis graduated from OWU in 1958 with a double major in Economics and Politics & Government. He was involved with Omicron Delta Kappa, worked on yearbook, and served as Eminent Archon of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity his junior and senior years. Denis was also Vice Chair of Interfraternity Council, and Chair of the Friday Chapel Committee.

Denis is Senior Equity Analyst at Colorado Financial Management. His previous roles include President of Atco Surgical; Planning Director, then Senior Vice President and Group Executive at Medical Products Group for Bristol-Myers Squibb Company; President of Valleylab, Inc. and Director of the Deming Center (Entrepreneurship Program) at the University of Colorado. While president of the Boulder Chamber of Commerce from 1987 to 1994, he helped double the organization's membership.

Denis's support started the Bishop Externship program at OWU, and he's worked tirelessly to expand the program and ensure it is accessible to students. He provided funding for the 2017-2018 school year to engage students in the career search early in college, and funded an external evaluation of the Office of Career Services to help strengthen and support the office.

He is a founding member of the President's Circle, a member of Tower Society, and was a member of the Woltemade Advisory Board.
