COLOR THEORY & ACRYLICS

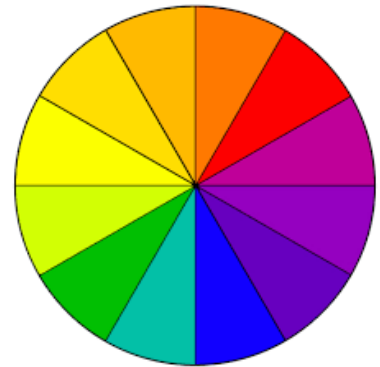
OCTOBER 14, 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM—GRADES 6 TO ADULT

SKETCHING & SHADING

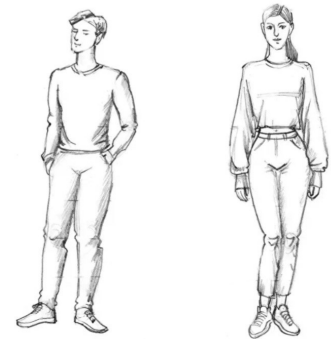
OCTOBER 14, 1:00 PM - 3:30 PM—GRADES 6 TO ADULT
