

## 2024 W-2 Local Wages Data Discrepancy – Your Action May Be Required

Dear Employee,

Recently, an issue was discovered that affects a specific data point on 2024 Form W-2, which may require your immediate attention. Due to an ADP technical issue, if you imported your 2024 Form W-2 data into your tax preparation service, Box 18 (Local wages, tips, etc.) may have been incorrectly populated with the same amount from Box 17 (State income tax).

**Please note,** however, that your W-2 received from ADP by mail, electronically, or accessed through the ADP Mobile app, are accurate and not affected by this matter.

## You are affected if you:

- Are required to file a <u>local</u> tax return in AL, PA, CO, DE, IA, KS, KY, MD, MI, MO, NJ (Newark city only), NY, IN, OH, OR, WV
- 2. Used a tax software or tax preparation service between 1/1/25 & 1/30/25
- 3. Imported W-2 local wage detail directly from your tax preparation service providers' platform.

**Important!** If you need a copy of your Form W-2 and you have online access to your pay information, you can view and print your W-2s anytime; go to Forms W-2 and 1099 Guide for Employees | ADP on adp.com to see how.

## If you already filed your taxes, you need to:

- Compare the local wages you used in your tax filing to the local wages on the W-2 you received directly from ADP.
- If the numbers match, no further action is needed.
- If the numbers do not match, you may need to file an amendment; please contact the tax preparation service you used for further guidance on refiling. They are aware of this issue and are ready to assist you.



## If you haven't filed, but imported local wages via tax preparation software, you need to:

- Compare the local wages you used in your tax filing to the local wages on the W-2 you received directly from ADP.
- If the numbers match, no further action is needed.
- If the numbers do not match, you need to update it with the number from the W-2 you received directly from ADP before submitting.
